- CAT 1 Expert racers must have a current annual USAC License.
- All other participants will either need to have a current annual USAC license or they may purchase a 1 day License at signup. Cost of one day license is \$10. This applies to all riders except "Kids" including those who qualify for a Free Entry class.

The course will be approximately 8 miles in length with mostly singletrack trail. The course is a unique mix of woods trails, open savannah, creek crossings and even a culvert to ride through. The course will be well marked with arrows and ready for pre-rides on or before July 8th.

Parking in Gravel Lot across the road from Pim-Day Use Area. Parking was very full in 2017. We will have a couple of Mo State Park Gators for hauling your pop ups, coolers and such to Feed Zone.

A separate Kidds class course will be marked and will be about .4 miles in length. The Kids course will remain open for Kids and parents use throughout the day.
